We will be exploring the book of Exodus this year. Exodus is a large book and we will be trying to preach its complete message, while not covering every verse in the book. It would be helpful to read the recommended readings before the sermon for that week. We will preach through Exodus in two sessions (April 24 - May 22; and October 2 – October 30)
